## What is this study about?

The goal of this study is to help researchers learn more about conditions that affect memory as we age.

## What will happen if I choose to participate?

If you are found to be eligible, we will ask you to complete parts of the study over 1 to 3 days. Studies are done at a UCLA medical center, and some can be done at home:

- Medical exam
- Survey about social factors
- Genetic counseling
- Cognitive tests
- Brain MRI (brain imaging)
- Blood draw
- 2-hour brain wave recording (EEG)

## Is this study right for me?

You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are 45 years or older AND
- Were diagnosed with:
  - Mild Cognitive Impairment
  - Alzheimer's Disease
  - Another form of dementia,**OR**
- You have no memory problems
- Identify yourself as Hispanic/Latino(x), Black/African American, or Asian American, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander
