

BIOMARKERS IN NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASE (BIND)

What is this study about?

This study collects various testing and brain imaging to learn more about memory-related health issues and aid in the discovery of new treatments.

What will happen if I participate?

If eligible, you will participate in the following during initial and annual visits:

- Medical and Neurological Exam
- Genetic Counseling
- Cognitive Testing
- Caregiver Interview
- MRI
- Blood Draw
- Overnight Sleep Study **OR** 2-Hour EEG
- Amyloid Beta and/or Tau PET scan (optional)
- Lumbar Puncture (optional)

Am I eligible?

You may be eligible if you are:

- 18 years or older
- Cognitively unimpaired **OR** diagnosed with one of the following:
 - Mild cognitive impairment
 - Alzheimer's disease
 - A condition related to Alzheimer's disease such as dementia with Lewy bodies, or frontotemporal dementia
 - Transient epileptic amnesia
 - Adult-onset epilepsy

Will I be compensated?

Participants will receive \$300 and their study partners will receive \$200 upon each study year completion.

Transportation, parking, and meals will be covered by the study.
